ATR VERDICT: KASTASA got the better of Hayyel to land the spoils at Sligo last time and could follow up. Dermot Weld's filly is 4lb worse off for winning less than a length, but she seems to be improving and could confirm her superiority in this. Cuban Surfer is an obvious danger after winning with ease at Naas two starts ago and just failing to reel in the winner at Leopardstown last time, with the step up in trip likely to suit Jim Bolger's filly. Altair is another to note on her handicap debut.
