




**ATR VERDICT:** NEVER ALONE fetched 1,200,000gns as a yearling and represents a potent stable in such races, and it won't be a surprise if the Dubawi colt is forward enough to land this on debut. A half-brother to 1,000 Guineas winner Legatissimo, he will likely get further in time but should have enough pace to cope with 7f for now. Frankel colt Prince Imperial is entered in next year's Derby and could be one for the notebook, while Royal Crusade, a stablemate of the selection, holds Group 1 engagements in the autumn and also warrants serious respect.
