ATR VERDICT: A return to this venue could do the trick for ANYONECANHAVEITALL, who was an impressive winner over course and distance earlier this month and wasn't disgraced five days later when third at Lingfield. Mark Johnston's Nathaniel gelding has enjoyed the step up to staying trips this year and rates as the one to beat here. An extra two furlongs and a first-time visor may be the key for Selino, who has been on the premises on all four outings so far including his handicap debut at Kempton last time. Agravain has a fine course record and must enter calculations, while Well Funded has gone close twice since winning at Doncaster in June and can't be ignored.
