TIMEFORM VIEW: It could be worth chancing SALAM ZAYED, 1 of 3 runners for Dr Marwan Koukash, who remains on a fair mark on his penultimate Ripon second and has a rider up who has been among the winners. Calder Prince is a big player under Simon Walker if the cheekpieces work as well as they did when he brought an end to a long losing run at Beverley. Baltic Prince could also figure.
