ATR VERDICT: Roger Varian has won two of the last four renewals of this contest and saddles an exciting individual in the shape of FARZEEN. The daughter of Farhh has improved leaps and bounds with each career start and arrives on the back of a comfortable victory under a penalty at Kempton last month. That performance suggested she was worth her place at this level and, for a stable with a fine record on Town Moor, gets the vote over Di Fede, who was fourth in a Group 3 at Goodwood on her latest start, and Angel's Hideaway, who is likely to be suited by a more conventional track.

ATR VERDICT: SAROOG is unbeaten in four starts over 1m6f, which includes his past couple of outings at Ascot and Newmarket. The son of Nathaniel went up 5lb for his most recent display and could have the scope for further progression. ATR VERDICT: It is difficult to oppose STRADIVARIUS once again with the star stayer having swept all before him this season, landing the Wetherbys bonus for the second year in a row at York last month. Despite having to give his old rival Dee Ex Bee an extra 2lb on this occasion, the five-year-old has proven to be tactically versatile against Mark Johnston's stayer and those pair are likely to be a cut above the remainder. Cleonte (11th) finished behind Barsanti (fifth) in the Ebor at York when they last met, but the step back up in trip will benefit Andrew Balding's gelding being a Queen Alexandra winner over 2m5f at Royal Ascot and he could prove best of the rest.

ATR VERDICT: Royal Ascot Norfolk hero A'ali has the best overall form in the book, though he was found out in Group 1 company in France last month and is unraced on ground guicker than good to soft at this early stage of his career. Wheels On Fire is an intriguing recruit to the yard of Aidan Fogarty and made some smooth headway when fifth in the Molecomb at Goodwood in July, but ALLIGATOR ALLEY was seriously impressive at York three weeks ago and could take some stopping. That effort can be upgraded given that he missed the break and it is well worth noting that the third from that event has since landed a Group 3 at Kempton.

ATR VERDICT: FLAVIUS TITUS ran too badly for it to be true at Goodwood in the ultra-competitive Stewards' Cup at Goodwood six weeks ago and could bounce back at a track where his connections have had plenty of success in the past. The four-year-old previously looked progressive when scoring twice at Newmarket on fast ground and would prove tough to stop if returning to that sort of form. Citron Major has proved a revelation this season and wasn't disgraced when third in the Great St Wilfrid at Ripon behind a winner who has since scored again twice, while Enjazaat drops in class and could be good enough for third.
