






**ATR VERDICT:** William Haggas is 6-18 with his juvenile runners at this venue in the last five years and, given that he landed this prize 12 months ago, is fancied to be targeting this maiden again with QASEEDA. A half-sister to 2000 Guineas third Skardu, who won on debut, it will be disappointing if this daughter of Poet's Voice doesn't know her job. Spreadsheet has twice finished second in his career so far and should appreciate this drop in trip, while Lin Chong completes the shortlist.

**ATR VERDICT:** Union Rose claimed his first win since January at Bath three weeks ago and a 4lb rise doesn't look too harsh based on his 2017 form, while Our Oystercatcher was an impressive C&D scorer a fortnight ago and should at least confirm that form with Indian Raj (sixth) here. However, KING ROBERT wasn't disgraced when deemed good enough to run in the Stewards' Cup consolation race at Goodwood last month. He has since shaped with promise at Windsor and a victory looks imminent.

**ATR VERDICT:** John Gosden has won four of the last seven renewals of this contest, including the last two, and debut Kempton scorer MISS YODA is difficult to oppose under a penalty. Handed a confident ride there on Polytrack, she holds an entry in the Group 1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket next month and is clearly held in high regard. Global Storm found the eventual Acomb winner too good on debut at Doncaster but proved slightly disappointing when holding the same position at Chelmsford three weeks later. Cosa Orga may prove best of the newcomers.

**ATR VERDICT:** A gelding operation appeared to help CASANOVA unlock his potential when landing the spoils at Wolverhampton two weeks ago and the three-year-old should have the pace to cope with this drop in trip. A rating of 91 could still underestimate John Gosden's charge and he is taken to prove too strong for Global Hero, who was a smart two-year-old but hasn't been witnessed on the track for 328 days. Alfred Boucher is on a hat-trick and also warrants respect.

**ATR VERDICT:** TUKHOOM has been extremely consistent throughout 2019, scoring on three of his 12 starts, and the return to handicap company, combined with Angus Villiers' 7lb allowance, can see the six-year-old back to winning ways. 
