ATR VERDICT: Union Rose claimed his first win since January at Bath three weeks ago and a 4lb rise doesn't look too harsh based on his 2017 form, while Our Oystercatcher was an impressive C&D scorer a fortnight ago and should at least confirm that form with Indian Raj (sixth) here. However, KING ROBERT wasn't disgraced when deemed good enough to run in the Stewards' Cup consolation race at Goodwood last month. He has since shaped with promise at Windsor and a victory looks imminent.

ATR VERDICT: John Gosden has won four of the last seven renewals of this contest, including the last two, and debut Kempton scorer MISS YODA is difficult to oppose under a penalty. Handed a confident ride there on Polytrack, she holds an entry in the Group 1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket next month and is clearly held in high regard. Global Storm found the eventual Acorn winner too good on debut at Doncaster but proved slightly disappointing when holding the same position at Chelmsford three weeks later. Cosa Orga may prove best of the newcomers.

ATR VERDICT: Quick has to be respected following her recent Brighton victory but a 6lb penalty will make her life tougher today. With that in mind, the preference is for SKYMAN, who won over C&D late last month and the unexposed three-year-old is only 6lb higher in the ratings this afternoon.
