ATR VERDICT: The Tooth Fairy was touched off by just a neck over 1m3f at Killarney last time and sets the form standard with her official rating of 71. Aidan O'Brien's charge is fairly exposed in the context of this race, however, so perhaps it might be worth siding with ANGEL FISH, who took a step in the right direction when fourth over 1m2f at Roscommon last time and could improve for this stiffer test. There may also be better to come from Proxy and Tidal Action.
