ATR VERDICT: LORD OF THE ALPS appears to be on a fair mark for nurseries and showcased that when second at Beverley 33 days ago. Mark Johnston's charge has yet to finish outside of the first three in four career starts, and could have his day in the sun under Joe Fanning.
