ATR VERDICT: Nietzsche has had a few attempts over fences now and despite winning twice at Perth, he hasn't fully convinced with his jumping, although the 2018 Greatwood Hurdle winner will be dangerous if everything clicks. Placedela Concorde was going well before falling over timber at Hexham, but a chance can be taken on NEWTOWN BOY. Promising when trained by Alan King, he was travelling well before unseating his rider at Market Rasen when last seen in May and might improve now with Keith Dalgleish.

Gris De Pron won for the first time since April 2017 at Sedgefield three weeks ago, while Canford Thompson landed a gamble here last week.
