ATR VERDICT: KING OF CHANGE ran an excellent race to finish second to Magna Grecia in the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, when outrunning his odds of 66/1. The son of Farhh was given a break afterwards with the intention of coming back for an autumn campaign and this appeals as an ideal place to return to action. Wootton has been gelded since his most recent start but he can enter the reckoning based on his second in the Group 1 Jebel Hatta at Meydan two starts ago, while any market support for Last Winter, a South African import who has placed at the highest level, on his first start for Sir Michael Stoute should be noted.
