**ATR VERDICT:** NORDICAN BLEUE was beaten at odds-on when last seen at Uttoxeter in July having got off the mark over timber at Southwell the time before. Despite giving weight to all of her rivals, this appears a winnable opportunity for Dr Richard Newland's filly on the evidence of what her rivals have achieved to date. Carpool produced her best effort when runner-up at Bangor last time and she can enter the reckoning along with Havacuppa, who finished third in a Fontwell bumper in June.

**ATR VERDICT:** SINAKAR travelled stylishly before launching his winning challenge at Uttoxeter nine days ago and could follow up under a 7lb penalty for a trainer who is 1-2 at this venue in the last five seasons. A step up in trip is expected to suit Kerry Lee's charge and this appears to be a good opening. Paddys Runner wasn't disgraced despite failing to justify odds-on favouritism when last seen 100 days ago at Fontwell, while hat-trick seeker Hot Ryan is also respected.
