ATR VERDICT: Richard Fahey has won three of the last eight runnings of this contest and is triplehanded this year, with Yoshimi looking his main hope off a fair-looking opening mark of 79 after a staying-on 7f success at Musselburgh. Fellow 7f winners Tell Me All and Plymouth Rock have also shaped as though this trip would suit and have been handed workable ratings, but ATHEEB could be better treated. Improving with each start to date, Sir Michael Stoute's charge powered home to land a 7f novice race at Haydock last month and a rating of 82 may underestimate him with further progress expected now up to 1m.
