ATR VERDICT: MUSTASHRY only finished five and a half lengths behind Enable in the Coral-Eclipse when last seen in July and sets a fair form standard. The six-year-old has a Group 1 success to his name, having struck in the Lockinge at Newbury in May, and assuming the ground is no worse than soft, he is expected to prove too strong for these rivals. Shine So Bright had looked progressive prior to an odds-on defeat in this company at Doncaster four weeks ago, while Limato makes some appeal back under Ryan Moore for the first time since June 2017.
