ATR VERDICT: CRITICAL TIME had been knocking on the door in maiden and novice company before winning narrowly on her handicap debut at Newcastle and the return to turf should pose no problems for William Haggas' filly. Maggies Angel won at Musselburgh two starts ago but struggled at Ayr last time and needs to improve for the extra furlong here, while Be More is consistent enough to make her presence felt.
