**ATR VERDICT:** TOUT EST PERMIS progressed nicely throughout last season, winning the Troystown at Navan and a Grade 2 at Thurles until not appearing to stay in the Irish National at Fairyhouse in April. Noel Meade's string are in fine fettle at present and he could have further improvement to come being a six-year-old. Balko Des Flos would have likely finished second to Kemboy at Aintree had he not made a bad mistake at the final fence and appears a solid threat, along with Alpha Des Obeaux, who ended last season with a solid effort in the Bobbyjo at Fairyhouse.
