ATR VERDICT: Sam Spinner was much the best of these over timber, finishing runner-up in last season's Stayers' Hurdle at Cheltenham, and could easily make a winning start to his chasing career, but a chance is taken on the less-exposed BEAKSTOWN. He quickly progressed through the hurdle ranks last term, impressively winning a Grade 2 at Warwick only two months after his maiden success, and the strapping son of Stowaway will almost certainly improve for this switch to fences. Mr Antolini is another exciting addition to the chasing ranks.

ATR VERDICT: SKY PIRATE ran well for a long way in the Kim Muir at the Cheltenham Festival before not appearing to see out the distance in the closing stages. The handicapper eased him 2lb for that effort and the drop in trip, combined with Jonjo O'Neill's 3lb claim, could see him back to winning ways.
