ATR VERDICT: SOUTER JOHNNIE is fancied to follow up his 1m Kempton success with first-time blinkers applied. He certainly wasn't stopping when opening his account last week and a 6lb penalty probably won't be enough to anchor him if arriving in the same mood. Sophar Sogood also won comfortably on his latest start, over 1m on Southwell's Fibresand, and he warrants respect off a 6lb higher mark, while Moorland Spirit, another going up in trip, cannot be ruled out either.

ATR VERDICT: JEWELLER improved plenty for the step up in trip and first-time blinkers when scoring very impressively over C&D by 13 lengths nine days ago.
