He subsequently disappointed at Aintree, when possibly feeling the effects of a long season, but he has the scope to take a step forward in this sphere. The Mighty Don enjoyed a good season against the best staying hurdlers, finishing fourth in the JLT Hurdle at Ascot, and he warrants respect along with Moonlighter, who appeared a long-term project in novice hurdles last season and has the potential to do very well now chasing.
