ATR VERDICT: SPOT LITE was deemed good enough to run in a class 2 event at Bath 38 days ago and should appreciate these much calmer shores for Rod Millman. The four-year-old has performed creditably on synthetic surfaces in the past, and has an ideal draw in stall one for this assignment. Katherine Place scored over C&D three weeks ago and doesn't have many miles on the clock for her age, while Edged Out, a recent narrow Lingfield third, is also noted.
