**ATR VERDICT:** Venetia Williams has a fine record in this race, including winning it 12 months ago. She holds leading claims once again with COMMODORE, who won both starts last season and could relish this stamina test on his reappearance. Not much separated Looksnowtlikebrian (fourth) and Arthur's Gift (fifth) when they met at Carlisle last month and both are respected, while I Just Know is considered reverting to fences following a pipe-opener over hurdles at Wetherby.

**ATR VERDICT:** THE WOLF returned a 17-length winner when debuting for Olly Murphy over this trip at Fakenham on his seasonal bow last month and is expected to show up well now switching to handicap company. Idilico kept on at the one pace when fifth over 2m at Wetherby and promises to be suited by this stiffer test, while Burrows Park is entitled to come on for his comeback run at Cheltenham and makes some appeal on his Kelso victory off 4lb lower in March.



**ATR VERDICT:** NAVAJO PASS and Politicise are closely matched on Flat ratings and both boast solid form with cut in the ground. The latter makes the trip over from Ireland and will likely know his job, but preference is for the locally-trained runner, who impressed with his attitude when winning over 1m6f at Carlisle in August. Dynali could edge out Martello Boy, another Irish raider, for third spot.

**ATR VERDICT:** Wbee brings solid bumper form to the table, winning by eighth lengths at Stratford on his latest outing in September, and must enter calculations on his hurdling debut, but preference is for runaway point-to-point scorer HEARTBREAK KID. Although you can easily pick holes in the form of his Kirkistown victory, he's clearly a gelding with lots of ability and it's worth noting that Donald McCain won this race last year. Timeforaspin is expected to improve on his comeback effort at Fakenham.
