ATR VERDICT: GRANDMASTER FLASH followed up his C&D second in October with another respectable handicap effort at Kempton last time. If running to his official rating of 85, Joseph O'Brien's three-year-old could take all of beating. Hannon has run creditably on both Flat starts and has been in solid form over hurdles recently so may emerge as the principal threat. Proxy and Elizabeth Way are likely better than they've shown so far.
