**ATR VERDICT:** JUGE ET PARTI impressed when landing a maiden hurdle in style under this rider at Hereford two weeks ago and is expected to remain competitive now moving back into handicap company. Miss Tynte is rated 11lb higher than when striking at Worcester in August and is feared most, while a big run from Maebh, who picked up the silver medal off this mark at Newton Abbot in the summer, would also come as no surprise.
