ATR VERDICT: The Trevor Hemmings-owned LOUGHAN is a son of Yeats and out of a hurdle and chase winner so is worth monitoring closely in the betting ahead of his racecourse introduction. If Dan Skelton's inmate is found wanting due to a lack of experience, Shirocco Sunflower, who finished a fair third on debut at Uttoxeter in the summer, could be the one waiting to capitalise. Olly Murphy's newcomer, Getaway Luv, is another for the shortlist.

ATR VERDICT: RUACANA bolted up by nine lengths over the extended 2m3f on his first outing for Zoe Davison here last week and is difficult to oppose now turned out swiftly under a 7lb penalty. Karakoram is rated 7lb higher than when striking over this trip at Ludlow last month but could feasibly play a supporting role, likewise Flaminger, who showed promise over timber in the spring and is worth a market check on his handicap/seasonal bow.

Venetia Williams' new recruit Hold That Taught is similarly one to monitor in the betting, while Darkest Day has place claims if building on his last run at Sandown.

ATR VERDICT: RUBY YEATS has had zero luck on her most recent outings, having been brought down when in contention at Fontwell before unseating when travelling nicely at Stratford last time out. Gary Moore's eight-year-old reappears off the same mark and has the chance to land a deserved victory at a local venue. The consistent Troubled Soul could build on her Chepstow reappearance dropping back in trip, with her handler's horses running well of late, while Lizzie Langton is respected, despite her best form coming over further.

ATR VERDICT: Fred Winter fourth KING D'ARGENT looked in real need of his Chepstow reappearance and could leave that effort in the past now stepping up in trip off a 2lb lower rating. The four-year-old received a wind operation in the summer and the benefit of that could be seen here with Dan Skelton's string thriving of late. Barntown appeared booked in for victory when falling at the last here seven days ago and has the chance to make amends off the same mark, while course-and-distance winner Deebaj and the useful Theo's Charm are foolish to rule out.
