ATR VERDICT: WINNINGTRY was a useful operator when with Paul Nicholls and, despite having a 741-day absence to overcome on his first outing for Chris Grant, it's worth noting that he has landed handicap success off this mark over a similar trip in the past. He could have too much class for these rivals if retaining his old ability. Oathkeeper is another who has operated at a higher level in the past and finds himself on a dangerous mark. Takingitallin has been running consistently well and looks to continue that form into the winter, with Carrigmoorna Matt another name to note.
