

TIMEFORM VIEW: TAKINGITALLIN was far from disgraced when runner-up in a mares' novice event at Bangor in October, particularly given she was operating under a double penalty that day. This rates much more suitable and, with a degree of potential intact tackling this longer trip, she rates a solid option. The Drone, back over hurdles, is next best, ahead of Oathkeeper, who should appreciate the ease in class.
