ATR VERDICT: Prince Dundee has finished second on his last four starts and is becoming frustrating to follow for Lucinda Russell, while Irish raider Unchago has been performing creditably in recent times but is rated 10lb higher on these shores. Recent C&D scorer CHANCEANOTHERFIVE slammed his rivals two weeks ago, shedding his maiden tag over hurdles at the 10th time of asking. An 8lb rise makes life tougher, though his confidence will be high and he's expected to give another good account.
