ATR VERDICT: Raymond Tusk has finished fourth in an Ebor and was deemed good enough to participate in the Melbourne Cup just 39 days ago, while Mildenberger wasn't disgraced in Listed company after a six-month break at Kempton last time and should appreciate this step back up in distance. Carnwennan and Dubawi Fifty like it here, but a chance can be taken on French raider FUNNY KID. He didn't beat anything home in Group 1 company at Longchamp last time, but previously looked progressive and has history in the UK after winning the Good Friday Marathon race at Lingfield in 2018.
