**TIMEFORM VIEW:** Smart performer RAYMOND TUSK is greatly favoured by these weights and arrives in good form too so he will prove very hard to beat if taking to tapeta and is impossible to oppose. Mildenberger also makes his tapeta bow and has the potential to throw down the biggest threat as he steps up in trip, while Sir Chauvelin has no ground concerns and appeals as the pick of the rest.
