



ATR VERDICT: Cotswold Way has struck the crossbar on his last couple of starts and is likely to give another good account, while The Big Bite can hopefully leave behind a disappointing effort on his chasing bow at Kempton. However, a chance is taken on Nicky Henderson's French import CARIBEAN BOY. He boasts some solid hurdles form, including when three-parts-of-a-length second in Listed company at Auteuil last time, and jumping is unlikely to be an issue on his fencing debut.
