ATR VERDICT: Last year's winner, and four-time course scorer, Lady Buttons is sure to have plenty of supporters and will almost certainly be involved at the finish. However, cutting back to an extended 2m and conceding 4lb to a mare five years her junior in FLORESSA is a big enough ask. The latter, a Listed winner at Newbury when last sighted, looks to be improving all the time and her sharp turn of foot at the business end could find out the popular mare. Irish Roe finished third in this 12 months ago and may collect another bronze medal.
