ATR VERDICT: Gavin Brouder got a great tune out of Moyode Gold over 2m4f at this circuit recently and she certainly wasn't stopping at the finish so the rise in distance for her handicap bow looks a wise move. Well Joey reverts from the bigger obstacles on a comparatively lenient mark but so does HIGHEST BENEFIT, who completed a Tramore brace prior to claiming third here. He is 19lb lower in this sphere and is expected to take full advantage. Thurles winner Ahgetawayoutadat has to be considered too.
