**ATR VERDICT:** Sunset Showdown has proven to be a consistent performer over hurdles and he has to be respected having finished a close second in a Pertemps Qualifier at Cheltenham last time. That said, the preference is for CLYNE. The 10-year-old's last victory came over C&D in March 2018 off just 1lb lower and he arrives on the back of a second-placed finish in a competitive contest at Chepstow last month. Flowery is another whose most recent form suggests that he could make the frame today.
