ATR VERDICT: HOLD THAT TAUGHT was unable to follow up a promising win at Lingfield on his Rules debut for Venetia Williams when underperforming at Leicester in December. However, the son of Kayf Tara can be forgiven that performance, as he was potentially unsuited by a relatively quick turnaround, and the step up in distance could unlock further progression. O'Hanrahan Bridge has finished second on all three hurdle outings and is likely to be in the mix along with course winner Multellie.
