





ATR VERDICT: Velvet Vision made it back-to-back victories when scoring at Chelmsford earlier this month and the course-and-distance winner makes plenty of appeal here. However, there could be lots more to come from CHARLIE ARTHUR, who was a comfortable victor over track and trip when last seen in November. He is only 6lb higher this time and Richard Hughes' four-year-old created a good impression with a string of top performances in the autumn. Windsor Cross has run well off this mark in the past and is respected, with Dr Jekyll also shortlisted following a handy third at Lingfield last month.

ATR VERDICT: BOLT N BROWN tasted success over hurdles at Ludlow earlier this month, and having placed off a 1lb higher mark in an amateur riders' handicap here before that, could take plenty of beating with Luke Morris taking over in the saddle. Mr Carbonator wasn't beaten far at Wolverhampton last time and is interesting stepping up in trip now tried in a visor. Motahassen has made the podium over track and trip the last twice and is another to consider, along with Pumblechook and Adams Park.
