**ATR VERDICT:** MARTHA BRAE lost little in defeat when second in a driving finish at Newbury and the fourth has franked that form by winning since. **ATR VERDICT:** SHELDON shaped with tons of promise when third in a hot Newbury bumper on debut (second bolted up next time) and with normal improvement anticipated, he is the one they all have to beat. Mocacreme Has attracted plenty of support ahead of his debut over C&D and ran on nicely into third. That experience certainly won't have been lost on him and he is likely to take a step forward, while Majestic Merlin and Sam Barton are two interesting newcomers.
