



ATR VERDICT: FUENTE gained compensation for his head defeat over 6f at Newcastle when scoring over the same trip here last time. Noted as staying on well in the closing stages on the latter occasion, Richard Fahey's charge is expected to take a 3lb rise in his stride and follow up over this longer distance. Like the selection, Ginger Fox now steps up in grade, having struck over this trip at Kempton last month, and is considered the main danger ahead of the consistent Calder Prince.
