**ATR VERDICT:** Stick With Bill performed as well as could be expected in the Challow and then proved that a mark of 124 underestimated him with a clear-cut win in a competitive Sandown handicap. He is rated in the 130s now but will do well to successfully concede 4lb to fellow Festival entrant LIEUTENANT ROCCO. The point-to-point recruit created a big impression at Chepstow and, crucially, handles testing conditions. Brummie Boys beat all bar a subsequent winner at Wetherby, while Mint Condition was fourth behind the exciting Shishkin at Newbury, although beaten a fair way.


**ATR VERDICT:** Sir Ivan was a 16-1 hurdles winner at Wincanton when last seen, but he hasn't been the most consistent throughout his career and left the impression that he wouldn't be certain to follow up. Bigmartre has had a wind operation and has dropped to a tempting mark, but a more reliable option might be SPRINGTOWN LAKE. Second on heavy ground at Chepstow over Christmas, the eight-year-old is 2lb below his last winning mark and could thrive under a likely front-running, aggressive ride here.

**ATR VERDICT:** Dan Skelton is 7-27 with bumper runners here over the last five seasons and could add to that record with BALLYCALLAN FAME. Second between the flags in Ireland, the winner of that race sold for 90,000 pounds at the sales last year, and she looks sure to go close on her NH debut. Lady Shirocco is interesting now under Rules for Ian Williams, who has also enjoyed some bumper success here, while La Reine Poutine is a half-sister to five winners and impressed when second on debut at Uttoxeter on New Year's Eve.
