ATR VERDICT: CORAZON ESPINADO failed to fire when last seen in March but he had previously been in good form and that included a C&D victory in January off just a 1lb lower mark. Outside of that most recent performance Simon Dow's five-year-old is a consistent performer at this track and he can be given another chance today. Dragon Sun could give the selection plenty to think about judging on his form from earlier in the season, while Lady Bowthorpe and Canal Rocks complete the shortlist.
