ATR VERDICT: This appears a good opportunity for MISS AMULET to get off the mark. She was seventh on debut at Naas, in a race that has thrown up several winners, before finishing fourth at Navan, when headed inside the final furlong of that stiff five furlongs. If she continues to progress, she should be hard to beat. Blueberry Faygo showed plenty of dash on debut at Naas when only caught close home by the favourite. There was cut in the ground that day which will stand her in good stead for this assignment, and she gets first-time blinkers. She is a major threat. Johnny Murtagh's Revolutme can get closer in this company while Colin Keane is a notable booking for newcomer Zoom Call.
