**ATR VERDICT:** BENTHAM has a shot at recovering Limerick's losses. He was well punted to oblige in Limerick but had to settle for second, two lengths behind a slick winner. That brings him right into contention for this assignment. He won a bumper at this venue last summer. The Broghie Man is tried with cheekpieces after finishing runner-up in his last three maiden hurdles. He has won twice on the flat on rain-softened ground, so may just want a bit more rain. Arthur Fonzarelli has fallen twice over hurdles but in the race he did complete, at Roscommon, he finished a decent second, so he has claims if his jumping has improved. Belfast Banter has plenty of ability, and will be sharper for a run on the flat in June.
