ATR VERDICT: BRAZEN BELLE made a winning debut over 5f at Beverley last month and that form has worked out well, with the third winning next time out and the second also going close. With that in mind, David O'Meara's filly is difficult to oppose today, despite her 7lb penalty, with this step up in trip likely to suit. More Than Lucky showed some promise on debut at Redcar and could prove the main threat to the selection, ahead of Gift List and The Queens Ladies.
