ATR VERDICT: A strong case can be made for many of these. The hat-trick seeking Star Of Cashel is an obvious starting point with Paddy Harnett claiming a valuable 7lb. The son of No Nay Never bolted up at Roscommon last week and it'll come as little surprise if he manages to strike again here. Preference, though, is for AMELIA JANE at the bottom of the handicap. Without a win in 12 starts, the Willie McCreery-trained bay has been knocking on the door of late and caught the eye when finishing a never-nearer fourth at Limerick on her most recent outing. The cheekpieces that were deployed for the first time at Greenmount Park are retained now and with Nathan Crosse taking 5lb off, she is sure to go close. Funny Little Ways had no luck in running at Naas recently and she is given second preference, while others for the shortlist here are Madaket Mystery, Early Bright and Cap D'antibes.
