







ATR VERDICT: COLONIZE was entitled to need the run at Kempton last time, given the 203-day layoff, but he was not beaten far on that occasion. The son of Empire Maker remains open to plenty of improvement and he should not be underestimated today. State Crown is likely to appreciate this step up in trip on his handicap debut and he could prove to be the main threat to the selection, ahead of Glenties and French Asset.
