ATR VERDICT: Dr Richard Newland has a good record at this time of year and there were plenty of positives to take from CAPTAIN TOM CAT's Southwell second earlier this month. Third behind Champion Bumper winner Ferry Hallow in a point-to-point last year, he clearly has some level of ability and could build on that reappearance/stable debut. Magnum displayed promise on his stable/hurdles debut for Lucinda Russell when a 40-1 second at Musselburgh in February, while Seeusoon was fourth behind the selection last time but could get closer on this occasion.

ATR VERDICT: FAMOUS RESPONSE was travelling nicely enough when sent off an odds-on favourite here in October, but he hit the deck at the fifth hurdle and hasn't been seen on a racecourse since. A long break should have done the six-year-old good, and this step up in trip might be just what he needs to get his confidence back. Aughnacurra King has had a wind operation after a modest stable/Rules debut at Southwell last winter, while Balagan was a 40-1 winner here 10 days ago and should remain competitive carrying a penalty.

He is clearly the one to beat, but might not represent much value. Arthur's Sixpence is interesting after a 368-day absence for Kim Bailey now dropped in trip, but ZEN MASTER might have a squeak here. Going well at Southwell recently before unseating his rider, the eight-year-old remains on a tempting mark and could score for the first time since October 2017.

ATR VERDICT: BUTTSBURY LADY is from a family her handler Nicky Henderson knows particularly well having trained both of her relatives, her half-brother Mill Green has proved to be a useful hurdler and the dam is a half-sister to top chaser Barbers Shop.
