ATR VERDICT: The Coolmore partners have three in here, two with Aidan O'Brien, and one with his son Donnacha. The trio in question are all Galileo colts and with current Ballydoyle number one Wayne Lordan aboard ONTARIO, that fellow gets the nod. Ontario is already 'a winner,' though demoted after passing the post in front at Fairyhouse on July 5th. He was a strong favourite then in a small field and got home by a short head from Reve De Voi. Rightly demoted there after slightly bumping the eventual victor, perhaps he can make it third time lucky on the slower ground at the longer trip. Ontario's stable companion Hms Seahorse finished in front of Snowy Owl when they met at the Curragh. He can confirm placings and follow the selection home. Halite looks best of the rest.
