ATR VERDICT: Stone Circle wasn't beaten too far in a competitive handicap on the Rowley Mile in June and could run another solid race. A few of these don't have many miles on the clock, though, and the twice-raced BAASHIR makes plenty of appeal. A winner at Salisbury on fast ground last month, Charlie Hills' Muhaarar colt travelled stylishly there and has more to offer over 7f before going up in distance. Stoweman may have needed the run at Lingfield and should do better.
