**ATR VERDICT:** John Gosden is 14-50 (28 per cent) with his runners here going into this meeting and his BARBER OF SEVILLE, a recent fourth over this trip at Yarmouth, will likely be in the shake-up if running to his official rating. There are other interesting southern raiders who have followed him north, however, and the 77-rated Captain Magnum has a strong chance for Archie Watson now stepping up from 6f. Godolphin representative Future Vision needs to show marked improvement to score, as does Ralph Beckett's Storm Dreamer. Karl Burke inmate Sonderbar, who was a promising second at Ayr, could be a bigger danger.
