ATR VERDICT: Bob Pebble enjoyed a solid first spin when third in a bumper here on UK/stable debut last month and should appreciate this extra yardage now hurdling, but TEMPLEPARK sets a high standard for this time of year and is fancied to defy a penalty for Fergal O'Brien. The seven-year-old is better known for his exploits over fences, but won cosily here by nine lengths over the smaller obstacles last time and appears poised to go in again. Noble Behest is rated 75 on the level and could take third.
