**ATR VERDICT:** The form of PETERBOROUGH's Stratford win looks rock solid with the second placing on his next two starts and there could be further success on the cards for Evan Williams' seven-year-old off a 7lb higher mark. Kiruna Peak shaped nicely enough on her chasing debut last month and has dropped to a figure she was a winner off over hurdles last summer. Chance It shaped nicely here over timber recently and is interesting reverting to fences, with Kapsize also worthy of respect now dropped back to two miles off an ever-decreasing rating.
